In addition, ACT is providing an ESTIMATED Relationship Table for institutions that also use the SAT (Critical Reading + Math + Writing) Score. This table provides a score on the SAT that is similar to an ACT Composite score. The values given are a very accurate representation of what you might get from a concordance table.

## College Readiness Benchmark Scores

The ACT is the only test with College Readiness Benchmarks directly measuring College Readiness Standards™, that are based on actual college performance of students, and reflected by specific test scores.

An ACT College Readiness Benchmark score is the minimum score needed on an ACT subject area test to indicate a 50 percent chance of obtaining a B or higher or about a 75 percent chance of obtaining a C or higher in the corresponding credit-bearing college courses. These scores were empirically derived based on the actual performance of students in college. ACT College Readiness Standards are subject-based knowledge skills statements that are informed by the ACT National Curriculum Survey®, directly measured by the ACT, and grouped by ACT score range.
