

What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment is the opportunity for students to take college courses and high school courses at the same time. The college credits may count toward both high school graduation and your college transcript.

Who teaches Dual Enrollment classes?

Courses are taught by qualified university faculty.

Where can I take Dual Enrollment classes?

Classes are taught at all Clarion University locations: Clarion campus, Clarion, PA; Venango campus, Oil City, PA; Clarion on-line.

Who can take Dual Enrollment classes?

Dual Enrollment is open to students who:

- *Are Sophomores – Seniors (who haven't graduated high school).
- * Have a cumulative 3.0 high school QPA or higher.
- * Submit qualifying results from the SAT/ACT, PSAT, PSSA tests or Keystone Exams.
- * Complete the Dual Enrollment application.
- * Obtain signatures from their principal, guidance counselor and parents.

What will Dual Enrollment Cost?

Funding exists to reduce the cost of a course for students meeting program requirements. Current costs: \$115 per credit plus a one-time \$50 nonrefundable records fee for new Dual Enrollment students. Each student is responsible for the cost of book(s) for their course. Students may enroll in one course each term at the reduced tuition rate; the second class in any term will be at full tuition & fees. (One term includes Fall, Spring, and one Summer Session)

Will my transition to college be easier?

YES! Transition from high school to college is made easier by:

- * Giving you time to adjust to rigorous academic expectations
- * Remaining in a more comfortable setting (your home or high school)
- * Smaller classes
- * More opportunities to ask questions

Will my credits transfer?

Your credits at Clarion University are already part of your official transcript – so you will be earning general education credits toward your intended major. If you decide not to attend Clarion University following graduation, we can help you transfer to the college or university of your choice.
