WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL FOR THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR FROM THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT!

It is hard to believe that the summer has come and gone once again. I would like to remind parents and guardians of a few important details for transporting children safely to and from school:

Please have your child ready and at the stop at least 5 minutes before the designated pick up time in the morning. The routes are very similar to last year's routes and, other than beginning of school hiccups, buses should run pretty much on time.

We understand that some parents require child care for their children. Please keep the following pointers in mind when arranging child care transportation:

1. The student and child care must both reside in the Neshannock Township School District.
2. The request must use an established bus route & stop; you must fill out a child care request form.
3. The bus requested must be able to accommodate additional students.
4. The student will be riding the bus on a regular basis. Regular basis shall mean one of the following scenarios:
 - a. Everyday AM and PM to and from child care.
 - b. Every AM from child care and every PM to his/her residence.
 - c. Every AM from residence and every PM to child care.
5. When a passenger overload occurs, students at child care locations will be removed from that bus to accommodate students living along such bus route.
